Number of Participants



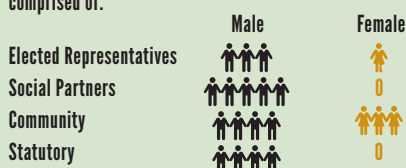
Funding by Government Department



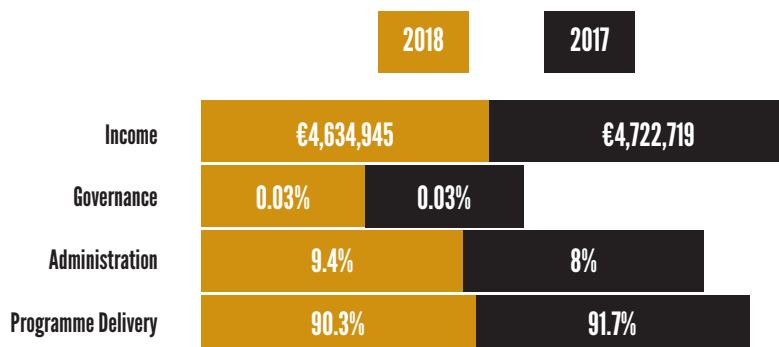
How Funding Supported Local Development Activities
